

GENERAL INFORMATION

There are well – equipped Science and Computer laboratories and libraries for experimentation and research work. Audio-visual teaching aids are extensively used to make abstract topics more interesting.

As quality rather than quality is our main objective, a team of qualified and trained teachers help us to achieve the target through their competence, dedication and hard work. To upgrade their teaching skills, teachers are frequently sent on training missions and workshops in the country and abroad.

CURRICULUM

The curriculum for Pre-Primary classes is mainly activity based focused on developing various skills of the child. Language development is through story telling and action songs.

In the Primary Section the main language taught is English while Bengali / Hindi is offered as the second language.

In the Secondary Section students are encouraged to work through meaningful project aimed at building essential analytical skills and designed to nurture their natural curiosity and inquisitiveness.

Incorporation of Value Education in the curriculum is aimed at instilling strong moral values in the young minds.

Making student's aware of their Environment through the Green School Programme in collaboration with the Centre for Science and Environment is also an essential part of the curriculum.

School Calendar - The academic year begins in April and ends in March. Saturdays and Sundays are weekly holidays. There are three vacations during the session. The Summer Vacation in May / June, the Autumnal Vacation in October and the Winter Vacation in December / January, These holidays may not be extended or anticipated.



CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Education provided at St. John School is meaningful and holistic for due stress is laid on co-curricular activities like Dance, Singing, SUPW and Physician Education.

There being four houses, Topaz Sapphire, Ruby and Emerald, inter house competitions in different games, quiz, dance, drawing and recitation are a regular feature. Students are also encouraged to participate in interschool events.

Field trips, youth camps and visit to local places of interest are a regular feature.

The students get a platform for showcasing their latent tolents through numerous school functions like independence Day, Teachers' Day, Rabindra Jayanti, Children's Day and Plantation Day. The mantle of leadership and responsibility is handed over to democratically elected student' representative at the Prefects' Investiture coremony.

ADMISSION

The school offers admission to children in Nursery. Admission in all other classes except class X and XII are open if seats are available.

- Admission age limit of Nursery is 3+years.
- The application form must be duly filled in & submitted at the of admission. Both parents must accompany the child at the time of admission.
- Students seeking admission in classes other than Nursery would have to sit short written test.
- The school authorities reserve the right to reject any application for admission without assignment of reason.
- No recommendation will be entertained.
- Admission charges are payable by a Bank Draft only in favour of St. John School.

Children seeking admission must provide the following documents:

- a) Birth Registration Certificate from the Municipality / Corporation as evidence of age.
 Original copy of the same is to be produced at the time of admission.
- b) Four Coloured passport size recent photographs.
- c) Transfer certificated from the school last attended.
- d) Last report card of the previous school
- e) Migration in original
- f) Registration Charge Rs. 9500/- in IX & X each
 - Registration Charge Rs. 10000/- in XI & XII each deposited in lieu of one month notice.
